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## (1) Individual Membership

### a) Full Membership

- (1) Full membership in the Association is open to:
  - (a) Any health professional, scientist or trainee formally affiliated with a member treatment centre.
  - (b) Any health profession, scientist or trainee formally affiliated with a hospital, university, government department, research institute, or like institution who is engaged in professional or academic activities in the field of hereditary metabolic diseases.
- (2) Applications from individuals wishing to become a Full Member of the Association must be reviewed by the Executive Committee prior to acceptance.
- (3) Rights and Privileges of Full Members:  
Full Members of the Association:
  - (a) Are eligible for membership on the Governing Council
  - (b) Are entitled to attend and vote at the Annual Meeting
  - (c) Are encouraged to serve on any standing or ad hoc committees of the Association

### b) Associate Membership

- (1) Associate membership in the Association is open to any person with an interest in the field of hereditary metabolic diseases.
- (2) Applications from individuals wishing to become an Associate Member of the Association must be reviewed by the Executive Committee prior to acceptance.
- (3) Rights and Privileges of Associate Members:  
Associate Members of the Association:
  - (a) Are entitled to attend the Annual Meeting
  - (b) Are encouraged to serve on any of the ad hoc committees of the Association that are open to Associate members.
