The Department of Pediatrics and Child Health and the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority Genetics and Metabolism Program are seeking applications for a contingent geographic full-time position in the program of Genetics and Metabolism:

The Genetics and Metabolism program is seeking to recruit an academic Metabolic Disease Specialist/Medical Geneticist. Certification in both Medical Genetics by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and in Clinical Biochemical Genetics by the Canadian College of Medical Geneticists is preferred. Candidates with equivalent training will also be considered as will Medical Geneticists with experience in metabolic diseases without CCMG certification. Pediatricians or Internal Medicine Specialists with CCMG Clinical Biochemical Genetics certification will be considered as well. Applicants must be eligible for registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. The successful candidate depending on interests and expertise can expect flexibility with respect to amount of protected time for research and the potential for exclusive time commitment to the pediatric and adult metabolic clinical services. Compensation is derived from fee-for-service income along with an annual supplementary payment as set by the Doctors Manitoba agreement. The position is located at the Health Sciences Centre.

The Department of Pediatrics and Child Health, University of Manitoba, comprises over 95 geographical full-time physicians representing all pediatric subspecialties. The Genetics and Metabolism program provides services to over 5,000 patients annually through clinics and in-patient consultations covering all aspects of genetics care including general genetics, prenatal diagnosis, metabolic disease, and cancer. The program offers a unique and exciting academic environment. The Medical Genetics Training Program is fully accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Our centre is also accredited by the Canadian College of Medical Geneticists for training in Molecular genetics and cytogenetics. Our program has close collaboration with the basic science Department of Biochemistry and Medical Genetics providing ample research opportunities. Equal emphasis is placed on clinical practice, teaching, and clinical and basic research.

Located in the thriving, multicultural city of Winnipeg, the University of Manitoba offers its 30,300 students and faculty a vibrant learning community through 82 degree programs, exceptional facilities, and the chance to explore ideas, challenge assumptions and turn theory into reality.
